Earning credits by examination

The **College-Level Examination Program (CLEP)** offers a series of examinations that permit students to demonstrate college-level mastery of common subject areas. NEBC students may take certain tests and receive credit toward their A.A., B.S. or B.A. degree. NEBC does not administer the exams, but examination locations may be found by accessing the College Board website at: www.collegeboard.org/clep/.

At the time of examination students must enter the **NEBC CLEP code (1968)** in order for scores to be properly reported to the college. Local testing centers include Andover and USM. Check the website for locations that may be closer to your home.

Students in the A.A. program may complete a maximum of 9 credits through CLEP and Bachelor's degree students may complete up to 15 credits. The following courses are the only courses that are presently acceptable for credit toward your degree at NEBC:

Exam scores range from 20-80 points, and the minimum required score required to receive credit for any of these exams at NEBC is 50.
