

Job Description for Part Time Pastor

Qualifications

- The candidate shall be beyond reproach and generally able to meet all the qualifications defined in Titus 2 and 1 Timothy 3 for overseer or elder.
- He shall be ordained or seeking ordination
- Academically he shall have earned a bachelor's degree or higher.
- Be able to ascribe to:
 - current church bylaws and statement of faith
 - Note: In regard to the pastor the current bylaws only define a full time pastor. Some requirements will be relaxed for part time work. Available upon request.
 - The Nicene Creed
- Desire to reach the community of Middleton and surrounding area.

Duties

- Preach the Gospel
- Administer ordinances
- Generally preside over services of public worship
- Attend monthly business and deacon meeting

Remuneration

- A parsonage can be provided free of the following expenses: rent, heat, electricity, internet, lawn care, snow removal.
- In addition an expense allowance is provided.

Hours

- Sunday morning, one evening mid week, and office hours equivalent of 1 day per week.
- Occasional weddings, or funerals etc.
- Available for special social activities such as: suppers, concerts, holy days
